## Display and Logistic Requirements for Group Art Shows

How to get your art on display at Art\*Bar. First contact Don Krause at Art\*Bar by email at [art.bar.riverwest.722@gmail.com](mailto:art.bar.riverwest.722@gmail.com) to discuss the details of your Group Art Show.

Some of the Art Groups that have shown at Art\*Bar are; CoPA, WVA, LMA, WPA, MARN, WIPAPA, Mke Sketch Club, The Martini Girls, and more.

First time groups displaying at Art\*Bar may have to provide pics or images of the art you're planning on showing for approval. Please understand that we're working on new art show requests all the time and have booking dates two or more years in advance.

A group show can consist of up to 50 works (depending on size) 9" x 12" to 30" x 40"

Larger format shows can display work up to 6' x 8' (needs prior approval).

Once your Group Art Show is confirmed, you'll be added to our gallery schedule and provided with the dates for your exhibit including the art drop-off date, the opening night date, the length of the show dates and the art pick-up date.

### NEW Rules for Group Art Shows:

Correspondence with Art\*Bar and the group needs to occur with only ONE person from the group. A leader, director, President, or person in charge needs to be appointed. Any questions about the show need to come from the group leader only. Also, do not call the bar, please use email only to reach Don at [art.bar.riverwest.722@gmail.com](mailto:art.bar.riverwest.722@gmail.com)

Individual Artists in a group show will no longer be allowed to drop-off or pick-up their art at Art\*Bar. Only the group Leader will have the permission to deliver the art and pick-up the art. These dates will be by "Appointment Only" scheduled with Don and the Group Leader. Usually the dates for drop-off occur 7-10 days before the opening date, and the pick-up occurs on the Monday after the show comes down.

The group Leader will be responsible for creating a gathering location for their group to drop-off and pick-up the artworks. Art\*Bar will no longer provide this location. Find a convenient studio, church, home, or school to serve as your groups drop-off and pick-up location to assemble your art show.

The group Leader will deliver the art standing upright in plastic storage totes only, with cardboard dividers between the art. NO Packaging materials wrapped on the art. No individual boxes, bubble wrap, blankets, tote bags, etc. are allowed! Corner guards can be used. All art must have an ID tag on the back and wired or sawtooth hanging hardware attached. The group Leader is responsible for providing a master art inventory list and art title tags for display. No late entries will be shown.

The group Leader will pick-up the un-sold art in the same plastic totes as delivered. All "sold" art will be kept at Art\*Bar for customer pick-up. All checks for sold artworks will be handed to the group Leader during the pick-up to distribute to members of their group. No checks will be mailed!

Art\*Bar only retains a 20% commission on SOLD Art.

#### IT'S JUST YOU:

If you're inquiring about showing your own art, and not a group show, we can suggest a group to join or determine if your art warrants a show on your own. (Requires 40 or more pieces to fill the entire space)  
Send us a link to your portfolio for review.

Does your art fit in one of our curated shows?

The Art\*Bar curated shows usually have 4-8 peoples work on display, based around a theme or medium. If your art fits the themes that we currently have on our schedule, please send us images of your work for consideration. They are ARTCANDY, GEEKART, FEAR, MOSAICS and Mini.

Note: Mini is a juried art show limited to 150 artist's and requires a submission process outlined in the "Call for Art" Mini Show, in August. Follow us on Facebook for more information regarding "mini show".
